Having been a resident of Coffs Harbour for over 40 years the traffic through our town is getting to a stage where it is not safe to drive within the town area.

Until such time as a bypass is made there should be a speed restriction with trucks and caravans driving through the own area.

First the speed limit between Halls Road and Brays Street should have a 50 km speed limit.

Secord all trucks and caravan should only be allowed to use the left hand lane only, this would enable cars to pass freely thus making it safer for cars travelling in the town area. At present you often have semis racing each other side by side. The town is too busy for this to happen and it is only time before an accident happens.
