I am responding to your notice re supply of Natural Gas and suggest strongly that due consideration be given to the town of Lake Cargelligo in the Lachlan Shire.

Lake Cargelligo is a town that is situated in the central western area of NSW and has been seen as an area to relocate to. In the early 1990's there was 5 manufacturing businesses that moved to Lake Cargelligo from the Sydney basin with a view of decentralization. These businesses have now become the backbone of the local economy and have been the inspiration of a further 5 manufacturing and distribution businesses that have started and grown into major town employers.

Natural Gas has many clear advantages in encouraging manufacturing companies to promote and help with the decentralization of industry into regional areas of New South Wales.
