## SUBMISSION ON THE INQUIRY INTO THE LAND VALUATION SYSTEM

- 1. This is my short submission in relation to the inquiry into the land valuation system.
- 2. I anticipate that my observations below are not directly relevant to the focus of the inquiry.
- 3. My recent experience in acting for the Office of State Revenue is that taxpayers have a very direct motive to instruct valuers in a way that produces a very low value for land. Often this is done by attributing value to supposed non-land assets. In my view such approaches are artificial and deprive the State of appropriate revenue.
- 4. To the extent to which your inquiry might deal with this issue, I would be pleased to provide further detail. Nevertheless I say no more at this point for the reason that I do suspect the focus is on different topics.
