

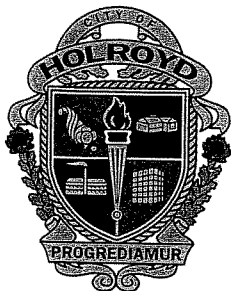

Dear Ms Allan,

I write to express Council's concern at the Federal Government's plan for the National Radioactive Waste Repository Project.

Council has further concerns that the Lucas Heights Nuclear Reactor will be decommissioned and that between 1000m<sup>3</sup> and 2500m<sup>3</sup> of high level nuclear waste will be transported through our City to this proposed repository.

We also understand that contractual arrangements for the sale of uranium are such that Australia will be required to take back high level nuclear waste from overseas. Accordingly, this processing of Nuclear Waste will require a port facility to unload and transport this waste, again through our City.

Council following representations from Loretta O'Brien, Nuclear Freeways Project Co-ordinator for Friends of the Earth, recently considered this matter. Council resolved to support the Friends of the Earth and to designate Holroyd a Nuclear Free Zone.

It would be appreciated if you could assist Council by supporting Council's call and conveying Council's opposition to the Federal Government's plan.
