Follow up of Auditor-General's Reports

I refer to advice received on Thursday 29 October 2015 requesting my comments on a response from the Department of Justice on Report No. 238 - Improving Legal and Safe Driving Among Aboriginal People.

As you will recall, I provided my comments to the Committee on 20 August 2015 in relation to the responses provided by the other responding agencies. As requested, I provide the following comments on this response to enable the Committee to consider it as part of its public hearings being held on Monday 9 November 2015.

We acknowledge the steps taken by the Department of Justice to implement the audit report's recommendations. In particular, we acknowledge initiatives to expand Work and Development Order completions among Aboriginal inmates.

Like Transport for NSW, the Department of Justice's response offers little detail about the achievements of the inter-agency working group or future strategies.

The Department notes that delivering on recommendations is hampered by 'mandatory licence disqualifications' for unauthroised driving. An important reform to overcome this obstacle is the proposal to allow people who have served out a certain length of disqualification period 'offence free' to be able to have the court lift the disqualification. We note that Cabinet has approved but is likely to revisit this proposal. The PAC may wish to ask the Department of Justice to provide an update on the status of this reform.
