

## Infrastructure Provision For Morisset And South West Lake Macquarie

This submission was prepared by Morisset Senior Citizens and Pensioners Association (MSCPA).

MSCPA is a branch of Combined Pensioners And Superannuants Association Inc.

We have 86 members.

This submission was endorsed by the branch at its meeting on 19 April,2005.

Our major concerns are:

- 1.The provision of a public district hospital at Morisset.
- 2.The provision by the NSW Department of Planning of reserves of suitable attractive areas of Crown land in the Lake Macquarie City area for low cost housing of a type appropriate for at least an additional 300 transportable homes.
- 3.The immediate provision of an After Hours general practice,bulk billing medical service and a public dental service at the Morisset MultiPurpose Centre.  
(At present only one local doctor bulk bills and she will not accept new patients).
4. A doubling of Aged Care places in Morisset.
5. An immediate start on the extension of Macquarie St to join the Mandalong Rd and the F3.  
(To remove the West Lake through traffic from the Dora St shopping centre.)
- 6.Sealing of the southern car park ,eastern end, at Morisset Rail Station.(This surface is eroded and strewn with large variable size gravel.Now it is uneven and dangerous to walk on.)
7. The immediate provision of a stop sign at the exit to the southern car park at Morisset station.
- 8.Reconstruction of the Morisset Park Rd / Fishery Point Rd intersection to improve traffic flow.
- 9.The provision of a public bus service on Sundays in the Morisset area.
10. The immediate provision of a proper pedestrian crossing near 59 Dora St( at the eastern end of the car park).
11. Straightening of sections of Fishery Point Rd and the provision of passing lanes in both directions between Station St and Yarrawonga Park Rd.
12. Enforce the timely development of community and recreational facilities on new housing developments,particularly on the former St John of God school site.,Morisset Park.
