Heads CP&SA we would like an enquiry into the state of dispair our Princes Highway is in also the condition of our own local roads as pools of water lay in holes that are due to bad drainage or disrepair. We have no bus services at weekends. Our HOSPITAL system is inadequate for an ageing population.A lot have to rely on foot walking to get to where they need to go, We do not have an aged care facility at Shoalhaven Heads. The closest one is at Nowra which is apro.23kls.away.You need cars to get there as the bus services are not always reliable and some people can not use them. There is Community Transport from Nowra but that is not always available when needed and is inadequate. Some of the aged and disabled have motorised SCOOTERS if they can afford to buy them but they are faced with another problem as other aged people have to use the footpaths then these scooters are forced out onto the road as ramps and sidestrips are non existant they are also are at the mercy of the weather conditions. Where puplic works and aged care facilities are concerned we believe Shoalhaven Heads is always forgotten.. Selfhad (Hon-Sec.)
