Two comments for your review----

Most European countries have only 2 limits in cities plus 1 for country roads and 1 for expressways----we have far too many in cities [10,40,50,60,70,80,100]. These are distracting for drivers and do little for for safety or traffic flow [despite what RMS may tell you].

The assessment of city limits is sometimes illogical, eg 10kph in Governor Philip Park in Palm Beach [too slow and always ignored] and 40kph in Avalon Beach and other busy town centres [too fast for safety]. These should both be replaced by the European limit of 25 kph which will be observed .
