Joint Select Committee on the Transportation and Storage of Nuclear Waste

Reference is made to your recent correspondence advising of the NSW Parliament's recently established Joint Select Committee to enquire into proposals by the Commonwealth Government, as part of the plans for a national repository for low level radioactive waste, to transport and potentially store nuclear waste in NSW.

Please be advised that any proposal to transport radioactive nuclear waste material across local government boundaries would attract significant community concern.

In this regard, nuclear activities including the transport of nuclear waste are **strongly opposed** by Blacktown City Council. In fact Council has a specific clause in its Local Environment Plan, which prohibits nuclear activities within the Blacktown Local Government Area.
