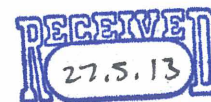

**RE: INQUIRY INTO DOWNSTREAM GAS SUPPLY AND AVAILABILITY IN NSW**

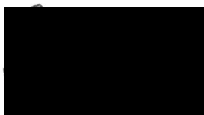
Council is in receipt of your correspondence dated 16 April 2013. Please be advised that Council does not have a domestic or industrial gas service provision. However, industrial development at Manildra, and expansion of industry there along with Canowindra & Molong would be assisted by the provision of natural gas pipeline connectors.

The Young to Wellington gas pipeline approved under Part 3A of the EPA Act proposed a pipeline through the central corridor of Cabonne, close to many of our towns and villages. Connection to gas from this line won't be available. Council has lobbied the proponent indicating local interest in connection.

Provision of gas at an affordable price would be supported by established industry and be a benefit to the growth and development of the shire.
