I AM ONE OF THESE PEOPLE WHO TOTALLY AGREE WITH THIS OUTLOOK RE THE LINE AS IT IS AND WAS IN THE PAST.

I AM OF THE OPINION THAT THE LINE SHOULD BE TOTALLY REBUILT, RE ROURTED TO A MORE DIRECT LINE ON TO THE GOLD COAST GOING THROUGH LISMORE AND ON TO MULLUMBIMBY, MURWILLUMBAH AND ON TO THE GOLD COAST TO CONNECT UP TO THE LINE COMING DOWN FROM BRISBANE.

A COACH SERVICE FROM LISMORE TO SERVICE BALLINA AND AREAS SERVED AT PRESENT, A SERVICE FROM LISMORE TO BANGALOW,/BYRON BAY A SERVICE FROM MULLUMBIMBY NORTH TO BRUNSWICK HEADS AND THE NEW LINE WILL BECOME THE MAIN BRISBANE /SYDNEY LINE FOR FOR PASSENGER TRAFFIC. A SMALL COACH OR TAXI AS REQUIRED TO FERRY PASSENGERS FROM CASINO TO KYOGLE.COACHES OR TAXIS COULD BE USED AS THE TRAFFIC WARRANTS TO SERVICE THE TOWNS SERVED AT PRESENT BY THE LARGE COACHES WE SEE EVERY DAY HERE IN CASINO.
