In response to the inquiry regarding driving offences, I submit the following information:

If a person is disqualified for driving under the influence or licence held pending same if it is found they are not over the limited for alleged drinking offence, their licence is then returned forthwith.

If a person is in similar situation but it has been apprehended on a drug matter, it is similar circumstances that if they are with the appropriate legal limits, they also would have their licence returned forthwith.

In my case, commencing the Thursday 28 October 2010, I have put on what could only be described as a treadmill. With license suspension, followed by cancellation of license, followed by license restored, under costly and ongoing conditions.
