SUBJECT: Discussion Paper on Strict and Absolute Liability Offences

Thank you for your invitation to comment on the Discussion Paper on Strict and Absolute Liability Offences.

The document includes a proposed set of guiding principles for considering whether Bills or Regulations that create offences of strict or absolute liability trespass unduly on personal rights and liberties.
