We moved to Bathurst from Penrith in July, 2011. We have found train the most economical and relaxing way to travel back to Sydney, given the high cost of petrol and congestion on Sydney's roads, plus the effort of finding a parking spot in Sydney.

However, having to book a seat on the coach to Lithgow, to then meet the inter urban train service to Sydney is most inconvenient. Standing on Lithgow Station platform waiting for the Sydney service on a cold, wet and foggy day is very unpleasant. It would be far easier if there was a regular Bathurst-Sydney service so that passengers could board and alight from the train once during the journey to Sydney.
