SUBMISSION TO THE INQUIRY INTO SYDNEY'S NIGHT TIME ECONOMY

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a submission to the Inquiry into Sydney's night time economy. I have been living in Sydney for five years and think that it is a more vibrant, diverse and safe place since the lockout laws were introduced.

I strongly oppose any watering down or removal of these laws. They save lives, prevent violence and ill-health, and they have improved Sydney. They have been effective in doing what they were supposed to do – why would you water them down?
