Dear Member,

I am writing to you in relation to the proposed coercive control bills currently before parliament being the

- Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Amendment (Coercive Control—Preethi's Law) Bill 2020
- Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Amendment (Coercive and Controlling Behaviour) Bill 2020

Both bills will gender prejudice men if passed. The facts are:

- that there is already sufficient legislation protecting men and women in relationships from coercion and spousal control.
- Men including myself are unlikely to report such behaviour
- Men are unlikely to know of such laws as they do not tend to seek relationship support.
- The bill therefore prejudices men.

The bills should not be passed.
