A reliance on animal protein as a significant source of calories is unsustainable and inefficient for the growing global population.

I ask the NSW government to do the following:

- Support farmers to transition away from animal agriculture towards food cropping
- Support and encourage the public to adopt a more plant forward diet
- Teach and support the public and organisations to grow their own food at home

- Further penalise and educate against food waste

- Ensure that plant based food growth and production receives the same subsidies traditionally given to animal agriculture and transition the latter off government subsidies and support

- Support fishing and aquaculture to move away from being animal protein focussed and to transition into a greater focus on aquatic plant growth, harvesting and processing for food
