## Inquiry into the accountability measures for decision-making for the delivery of the Critical Communications Enhancement Program

I refer to your correspondence on 9 November 2023 in respect of the above NSW Legislative Council Public Accounts Committee inquiry.

The role of OTSI is to improve safety and enhance public confidence in the safety of the NSW transport network, which we achieve by:

- Undertaking independent investigation of transport incidents and accidents
- identifying system-wide safety issues and their contributing factors
- sharing safety lessons and making recommendations or highlighting actions that transport operators, regulators and other stakeholders can take to improve the safety of bus, ferry and rail passenger and rail freight services.
