The country is imploding in youth crime, and I would like to see Magistrates held accountable for their poor decisions that result in the public being hurt or victimised after a youth has been to court and let out on bail or let off.

We have a degrading population in Moree and we are the gate way to the west, I would like to see a conversation of a youth detention Centre established in Moree.

we are just over a population of 7000 which is half of what it was in 1988.

Over the time we have seen the local catholic school go from being a primary school to being a part high school providing classes to year 10 students. The local Lutheran school is doing the same.

We also have the 2 public high schools with teachers spread over the two schools.

Is it all possible that as a small population we could go back to one high school and use the Courallie High school as a detention centre.

It provides a solid structure a well fenced perimeter and the ability of a learning centre for detain youth.

Obviously, modifications to fencing, surveillance and room structures would need to be made.

This would allow time for a study to be done on the youth problems that would be able to be detained, kept safe and allow the community its safety back and its possessions safe.
