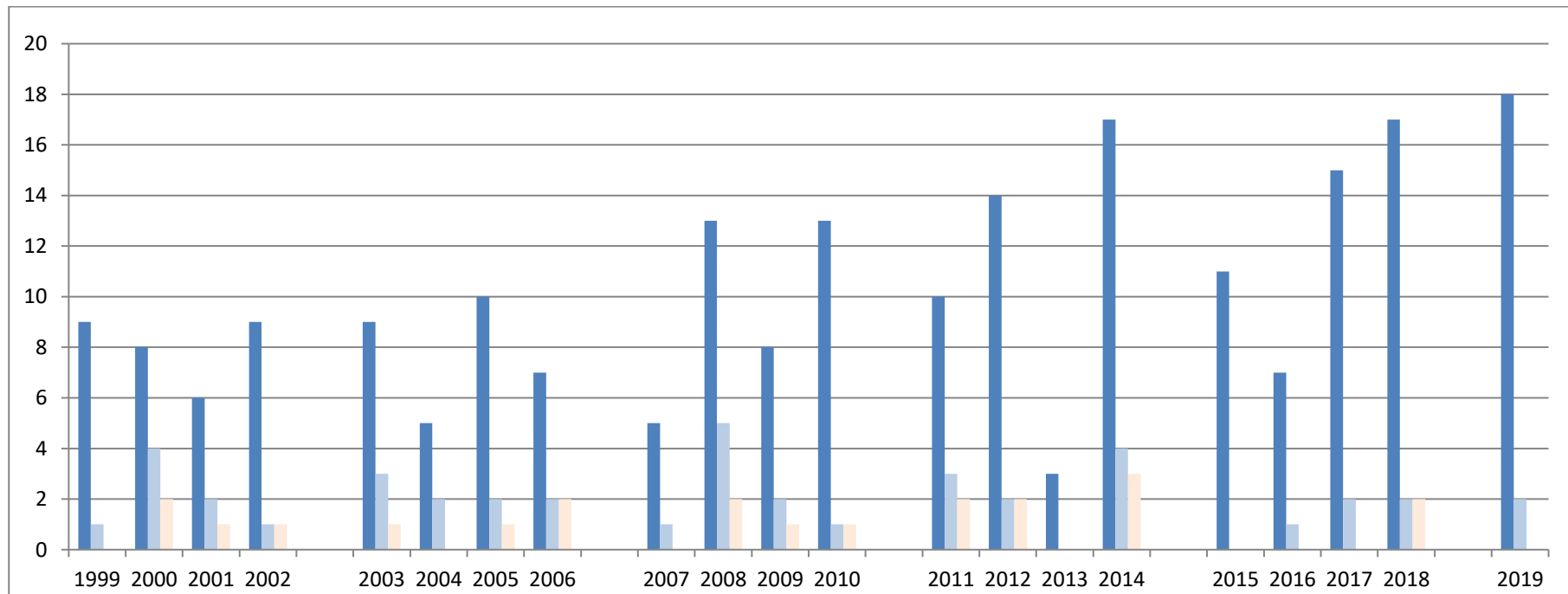


## Private Members' Bills introduced in the Council per calendar year since 1999\*
