## JOINT INQUIRY INTO RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ICAC REGARDING ASPECTS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS, THE INTEREST DISCLOSURE REGIME, AND A PARLIAMENTARY INVESTIGATOR

The Legislative Council Privileges Committee and the Legislative Assembly Committee on Parliamentary Privileges and Ethics are to inquire jointly into matters arising from the ICAC Report entitled "Reducing the Opportunities and Incentives for Corruption in the State's Management of Coal Resources". The Committees will focus on:

- a) The Codes of Conduct for Members of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly;
- b) The interest disclosure regime for Members of Parliament;
- c) The role and need for a parliamentary investigator;
- d) Any other related matter.

The Committees are inviting submissions as part of the inquiry. Closing date for submissions: **Friday 14 March 2014**.
