The Selection of Bills Committee met on Tuesday 11 May to consider whether the following bills be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report:

- Payroll Tax Amendment (Jobs Plus) Bill 2021
- Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2021
- Coal and Gas Legislation Amendment (Liverpool Plains Prohibition) Bill 2021
- Petroleum (Onshore) Amendment (Cancellation of Zombie Petroleum Exploration Licences) Bill 2021
- Protection of the Environment Operations Amendment (Clean Air) Bill 2021
- Work Health and Safety Amendment (Industrial Manslaughter) Bill 2021
- Tax Administration Amendment (Combating Wage Theft) Bill 2021

 - (b) the bill be referred to the committee at the conclusion of the mover's second reading speech,
 - (c) the resumption of the second reading debate on the bill not proceed until the tabling of the committee report,
 - (d) the committee report by 12 August 2021.

- (3) That:
 - (a) the Protection of the Environment Operations Amendment (Clean Air) Bill 2021 be referred to Portfolio Committee No. 7 – Planning and Environment for inquiry and report,
 - (b) the bill be referred to the committee at the conclusion of the mover's second reading speech,

- (c) the resumption of the second reading debate on the bill not proceed until the tabling of the committee report,
 - (d) the committee report by 27 August 2021.
- (4) That the following bills not be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report, this day.
- (a) Payroll Tax Amendment (Jobs Plus) Bill 2021,
 - (b) Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2021,
 - (c) Work Health and Safety Amendment (Industrial Manslaughter) Bill 2021, and
 - (d) Residential Tenancies Amendment (Reasons for Termination) Bill 2021.
