3	That Local Land Services publish the guidelines made under cl 19A(5) of the Land Management (Native Vegetation) Code 2018 by the end of this calendar year	Supported and completed – the Guidelines were published on 19 December 2019
4	That the Legislative Council not disallow the <i>Local Land Services Amendment (Allowable Activities) Regulation 2019</i>	Supported
5	That the NSW Government issue guidance on the application of the following instruments to coastal wetlands and littoral rainforest and relevant proximity areas, as a matter of urgency: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Local Environment Plans• State Environmental Planning Policy (Coastal Management) 2018• State Environmental Planning Policy (Vegetation in Non-Rural Areas) 2017• <i>Local Land Services Act 2013</i>	Supported – relevant agencies within the Department of Regional NSW and the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment are developing this guidance.
