- First Home Buyer Legislation Amendment Bill 2023 (not yet accompanied by a Statement of Public Interest)
- Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment (Digital Evidence Access Orders) Bill 2023 (not yet accompanied by a Statement of Public Interest)
- Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2023 (accompanied by a Statement of Public Interest).

The committee makes the following recommendations:

- (1) That:
 - (a) the provisions of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment (Housing and Productivity Contributions) Bill 2023 (not yet accompanied by a Statement of Public Interest) be referred to Portfolio Committee No. 7 – Planning and Environment,

 - (c) the committee report by 31 July 2023.

6 SELECTION OF BILLS COMMITTEE—REPORT

- (1) That:

- (2) That the following bills not be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report, this day:

 - (b) Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment (Digital Evidence Access Orders) Bill 2023, and
 - (c) Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2023.
