NSW Upper House inquiry into enrolment capacity in inner city public primary schools to hold public hearing

The Upper House committee inquiring into enrolment capacity in inner city public primary schools and the redevelopment of Ultimo Public School will hold a public hearing on Friday 25 November 2016.
