The placement panel process and procedures with regard to the allocation of integration funding and student placement needs to be consistent across the state. There needs to be a transparent process understood by all concerned.

There needs to be ongoing professional learning and resources provided to School Learning Support Teams in the preparation and submission of Integration Funding applications so that consistency of approach and equity in distribution of resources can be achieved.

Early intervention is critical in the identification of students presenting with a disability so that appropriate resources can be put in place.

There needs to be the appointment of early childhood consultants to provide timely identification of students with additional needs and liaison with all major stakeholders.

There needs to be resources provided to enable the coordination of trans-disciplinary teams, in conjunction with health professionals to identify the needs of children with disability to facilitate early referral to appropriate services.
