

Thank you. I've attached the transcript with three minor errors indicated on pages 21 ('foreign particles'), p.22 (the 10 year objective of 7 has been dramatically 'exceeded' - not 'increased') and page 23 ('we have had 24 hour average concentrations up to 83.4 which is more than three times the national standard for exposure to particulate matter PM2.5' ).

Hon Penny Sharpe requested figures on the number of times that particle pollution has exceeded the national standards at St Mary's, Richmond and Prospect.
