SECOND PUBLIC HEARING FOR INQUIRY INTO THE WINDSOR BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

An Upper House committee inquiring into the Windsor Bridge replacement project will hold its second public hearing in Parliament House Sydney, on **Monday 7 May 2018**.

The committee will hear from Roads and Maritime Services and Transport for NSW, technical experts and a proponent of the project.

The committee Chair, the Hon Robert Brown MLC said, “The Windsor Bridge is an important piece of infrastructure and is highly valued by the local community. The committee will listen to and carefully consider the evidence of all key stakeholders to make measured and informed recommendations regarding the replacement project”.

The hearing will commence at 10.30 am at Parliament House, Macquarie Street, Sydney. The hearing is open to the public and will be webcast live via the Parliament’s [website](#).
