An Upper House committee will be holding its first public hearing on Friday 18 May 2018 for the inquiry into Parklea Correctional Centre and other operational issues.

The Chair of the Committee, the Hon Robert Borsak MLC said, “Parklea Correctional Centre was privatised in 2009. The inquiry is examining the current operation of the correctional centre by GEO Group. The hearing will provide the opportunity to take evidence from both GEO Group and Corrective Services NSW.”

The hearing will be held in the Macquarie Room at NSW Parliament and will run from 1.30 pm to 4.45 pm. The hearing will be webcast and can be viewed on the NSW Parliament website at: www.parliament.nsw.gov.au/.
