SECOND PUBLIC HEARING FOR INQUIRY INTO SYDNEY STADIUMS STRATEGY

The Upper House committee inquiring into the Sydney stadiums strategy will hold its second public hearing on **Friday 29 June 2018** in Parliament House, Sydney.

The committee will hear from the Office of Sport, Mr John Brogden, Netball NSW and Basketball NSW.

Representatives from Saving Moore Park, Keep Sydney Beautiful, KPMG, Blackett Maguire + Goldsmith, and MI Associates will also appear.

The Chair of the committee, the Hon Robert Brown MLC, said "Following on from the evidence received at the first hearing, the Public Works Committee will examine closely the process by which the stadiums strategy was developed, the economic and social justifications underpinning the strategy, and the impacts of the strategy on local communities".

The hearing will commence at **9.00 am at Parliament House, Macquarie Street, Sydney**. The hearing is open to the public and will be webcast live via the Parliament's [website](#).

A third public hearing is scheduled for 6 August 2018.
