**QUESTION**

**Mr ELLIS:** It is within days of being completed. We are maintaining very close contact with Infrastructure NSW. They will have that input. We have been engaging with them on a progressive basis, so they understand the issues that we have been raising progressively.

**Mr JUSTIN FIELD:** The Committee heard earlier today from Mr Betts that they have completed the EIS and that it was imminent. It could even be put on display for public comment within a matter of days, if not weeks. Clearly they have moved forward without your submission.

**Mr ELLIS:** I would assume that the reason why it is days away is because they are waiting for our submission to be able to complete the EIS.

**Mr JUSTIN FIELD:** They said as far as they are concerned it is completed.

**Mr ELLIS:** I cannot speak for them. My assumption is that they are waiting on our submission before they release it finally.

**Mr JUSTIN FIELD:** I do not think that is their assumption.

**The Hon. JOHN GRAHAM:** The Committee would appreciate it if you could take that on notice and check that.

**ANSWER**

I can confirm our response was finalised and submitted on 8 June 2018.

We will continue to fully engage in the EIS process as it progresses.
