Question on Notice

In New South Wales, what is the split between generation and sale and consumption?

Response

As at 30 June 2018, AGL's effective generation capacity in NSW totalled 4,555 MW (see table below). In FY17, AGL generated 24,442 GWh of which 18,799 GWh was supplied to meet AGL customer demand. An additional 4,643 GWh was sold to other market participants on substantially the same terms. AGL has an obligation through the Macquarie Generation acquisition process to provide a minimum 500 MW of Flat Swap to the NSW market, equivalent to 4,380 GWh per annum. Since 2014, AGL has consistently exceeded this amount.

During FY18, AGL made financial commitments to proceed with 100 MW turbine efficiency upgrades at Bayswater Power Station (approximately \$129 million) and up to \$390 million to develop a 252MW gas fired power station at Tomago, NSW.

Supplementary Question

What components of a bill, if any, are exempt for people accessing hardship provisions?

Response
