FINAL PUBLIC HEARING FOR INQUIRY INTO SYDNEY STADIUMS STRATEGY

The Upper House committee inquiring into the Sydney stadiums strategy will hold its final public hearing on Monday 6 August 2018 in Parliament House, Sydney.

The committee will hear from the Department of Planning and Environment, the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Trust, Infrastructure NSW and the North Parramatta Residents Action Group. Representatives from the National Rugby League, the Football Federation Australia, Cricket NSW, and Rugby Australia will also appear.

The Chair of the committee, the Hon Robert Brown MLC, said "Following on from the evidence received at the previous two hearings, the Public Works Committee will further examine the process by which the stadiums strategy was developed, the cost benefit analyses that informed the strategy and the attendance rates of patrons to Sydney's stadiums, presently and into the future".

The hearing will commence at 9.15 am at Parliament House, Macquarie Street, Sydney. The hearing is open to the public and will be webcast live via the Parliament's website.
