We understand that SIRA needs to review the filing before approving, however, we are concerned that icare is at risk of being in breach of the MPPG under point 8.1.6 of the filing.

8.1.6 Licensed insurers must notify insured employers of the renewal of their policies no less than six weeks prior to the date of renewal.

Please can you confirm that not issuing renewals in the time required will not be viewed by SIRA as non-compliant. As soon as SIRA gives the approval, we are ready to deliver renewals to our customers.

Please let me know if there is anything else you need to facilitate the approval.
