

1. Can you supply us with any more information about the 'Live at the Steps' functions?

Live At The Steps was a free, all-ages event at Parliament Steps Melbourne, held during Melbourne Music Week in 2016 and 2017. The events were attended by more than 10,000 young people and featured live performances from notable Australian artists including The Jungle Giants, Skegss, Baker Boy, Tired Lion, Gretta Ray, Aunty Donna and Philly. Produced in partnership with Parliament of Victoria's community engagement strategy, the event aimed to provide opportunities to develop stronger connections between Parliament and young people from across Victoria. This was achieved through the collaborative program model that supported 15 participants of The Push's New Slang underage events team to take lead roles in the curation, marketing and production of the event. Each event was delivered with a project budget of up to \$50,000. This was funded through the Parliament of Victoria, with in-kind contributions from The Push, City of Melbourne and triple j.
