INQUIRY INTO THE SUSTAINABILITY OF THE DAIRY INDUSTRY IN NEW SOUTH WALES

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE 18 October 2018

An Upper House committee has commenced an inquiry into the long-term sustainability of the dairy industry in New South Wales and the role of the Department of Primary Industries and other government agencies in supporting the industry.

The Chair of the committee the Hon Robert Brown MLC said, 'This inquiry will examine the nature of, and relationship within, the value chain between farmers, processors and retailers and how these factors influence the price of dairy products.'

Mr Brown continued, 'We will consider the impact of external influences on the dairy industry, including drought, water, energy, price setting and previous policies including deregulation of the industry. The committee will also look at the role of government in addressing the economic challenges faced by the industry.'

The committee will hold public hearings in November and report back to Parliament by 14 December 2018.
