As the largest producer of eggs in Australia, NSW has to be a leader in animal welfare when it comes to the treatment of laying hens.

Battery cages prevent hens from carrying out their natural behaviours, such as nesting and foraging – let alone allow them enough room to even stretch their wings.

Such a life is cruel and leads to a number of serious health problems in hens including brittle bones and fractures as well as higher rates of disease.
