Biobanks EPBC conditions being ignored - No additional Koala habitat protection conferred.

The federal Department of the Environment and Energy has been ignored. It conditionally approved Gilead (EPBC 2015/7599) but rejected the NSW's DPE's use of an existing council bush reserve 'Noorumba' as a Koala biobanking credit and has asked for a Koala Management Plan (KMP) before proceeding. NSW Biodiversity Credits as per the Earthworks DA 3868/2017/DA-CW condition 21b must conform with condition 5 of the EPBC 2015/7599 for approval.

However the NSW DPE have approved Campbelltown Council's Noorumba Bush Reserve as a Biobank under the **Biocertification Stewardship Agreement** (gazetted on July 5th this year (n2019-1900) see BioBanking agreement ID number: 239). The retirement of credits under a **Biodiversity Stewardship** site listed on the public register:

- 104 HN556 Biodiversity Credits, and 85 Koala species credits, from Macarthur-Onslow Mt Gilead - ID 208.
- 2. 28 HN528 Biodiversity Credits, and 48 Koala species credits, from the **Noorumba-Mt Gilead** ID 209.
- 3. 151 Koala species biodiversity credits from Campbelltown Council's Noorumba Bush Reserve ID 239.

The EPBC approval specifically negates the use of the 'Noorumba Bush Reserve' as there is no additionality (it's an existing bush reserve) and because the exclusion fencing makes it meaningless as a Koala Species Credit (no Koala can get there). And the onsite biobanks also have no Koala credit function if Koalas can't reach them. Condition 5 of the EPBC 2015/7599 states a site in West Appin must be secured to retire these Koala credits.

"5. To compensate for impacts on Koala, the approval holder must acquire or retire no less than 150 Biodiversity credits for the Koala from the Appin West offset site prior to the commencement of the action."


Condition 21b of the Gilead Earthwork DA states prior to the commencement of works the following must be provided to Council:

"21b. Evidence of the retirement of biodiversity credits as per Condition 3-5 of the approval issued under the EPBC Act (Mt Gilead residential development EPBC 2015/7599), dated 21 December; "

The Biocertification Stewardship Agreement - ID 239 uses Noorumba, not West Appin as a required Koala Credit per condition 5 of the EPBC.

A requirement of the Earthworks DA is EPBC Biobank retirement. There is no evidence that this has been retired. The July 5th Biodiversity Certification Agreement that this DA appears to rely





upon applies to Noorumba, not West Appin, and therefore does not meet EPBC Biobank conditions.

ANNEXURE A - CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Part A - Conditions specific to the action

The approval holder must ensure that clearing of protected matters within the proposed action area is limited to the area marked as 'development area' in Attachment 1.

- To offset the impacts on 3.3 ha of SSTF and 0.55 ha of CPW, the approval holder must ensure that 8 ha of SSTF and 1.2 ha of CPW is secured within onsite offset areas prior to the commencement of the action.
- To offset the impacts on 1.79 ha of SSTF, the approval holder must secure a minimum of 4 ha of SSTF at the Fernhill Central West biobanking site prior to the commencement of the
- To compensate for impacts on 0.85 ha of SSTF not compensated through offsetting through conditions 2 and 3, the approval holder must either:
 - secure 0.85 ha of SSTF within the Council reserve prior to the commencement of Stage 2 of the action; or (if the approval holder is unable to register the Council reserve as a BioBank site);
 - submit for the Minister's approval, an offset strategy in accordance with the EPBC Act environmental offsets policy. The offset strategy must outline how these impacts will be offset in perpetuity. The offset strategy should be submitted at least three months prior to the intended date of **commencement**. The approval holder must not commence the action unless the offset strategy has been approved by the Minister
- To compensate for impacts on Koala, the approval holder must acquire or retire no less than 150 Blodiversity credits for the Koala from the Appin West offset site prior to the commencement of the action.
- Within 10 business days of securing the relevant offsets specified in conditions 2 5, the approval holder must provide the Department with evidence of when the offsets were secured and what mechanism was used to secure the offsets.
- Prior to the commencement of the action, the approval holder must prepare and implement Prior to the commencement of the action, the approval holder must prepare and implement as Koala Management Plan for the proposed action area to the satisfaction of the Minister. This must include provisions for the approval holder to contribute at least \$50,000 each year for five years to fund activities outlined in the plan. The approval holder must provide the Department with evidence of the Koala Recovery Team's endorsement of the Koala Management Plan prior to the commencement of the action. The first year's contribution must be made within 20 business days from the commencement of the action.

Schedule 3 Approved measures

The approved measures under this order are as follows:

- The entering into a blodiversity banking agreement over the Conservation Area as a Conservation Measure and the subsequent retirement of all Biodiversity Credits generated from that site.
- The retirement of 104 HNS56 Biodiversity Credits, and 85 Koala species credits, generated from the Macarthur-Onslow Ntt Glead Biodiversity Stewardship site listed on the public register with ID 208.
- The retrement of 28 HN528 Biodiversity Credits, and 48 Koala species credits, generated from the Noorumba-Alt Glead Biodiversity Stewardship site Isted on the public register with [0 209,
- The retirement of 151 Koala species blodiversity credits as referred to in the Biodiversity Stewardship Agreement listed on the public register with ID 239.

Timing of the implementation of conservation measures

- The conservation measures set out in clauses 1-4 above, must be implemented within the timeframes set out in the Biodiversity Certification Agreement entered into by the following parties in relation to this blockwarsity certification:


