Dear Mr Richards

I understand that there is a Standing Order 52 in relation to the register of buildings with potentially combustible cladding.

In considering the potential security implications related to releasing specific location information identifying premises, residential and commercial, which may have combustible cladding, the NSWPF view from a security perspective, is that it would not be in the public interest for specific information of this nature to be made public.

This opinion has been determined from a general security perspective only, taking into consideration the potential risk of publicly identifying assets with a flammable vulnerability.
