Hi Sarah.

I appeared at the Inquiry last Thursday in Newcastle. I took some matters regarding combustible cladding on notice. I provide the following further information;

- 28 buildings owners voluntarily listed on the register within the Central Coast Council Local Government Area.
- 17 buildings have been assessed as no or low risk and require no further action.
- 11 buildings are low to medium risk, with further investigations currently under way.
- 4 of the 11 buildings are public, NSW government owned buildings.
- Councils Fire Safety officer is liaising with building owners for the remaining 7 buildings, and monitoring their progress on further investigation work and mitigation / removal of any risk.
