Apologies for the delay. Mr Hudson and I sort clarification from the Firearms Registry. I have made some amendments to your draft. The Firearms Registry has informed us that the figures did include temporary administrative positions but not the contingent labour. I have also made an amendment to 30 June 2019 reducing it in lieu of 97.

Mr Hudson and A/ Assistant Commissioner Cook approve the amendments.

Number of Approved, Filled and Vacant Positions, as at:

March 2017: 92 positions (76 headcount, 17 vacancies)

May 2018: 95 positions (81 headcount, 16 vacancies)

July 2018: 95 positions (79 headcount, 17 vacancies)

June 2019: 95 positions (76 headcount, 27 vacancies).

Figures include temporary administrative staff but does not include personnel recruited under contingent labour arrangements. There are currently 10 staff employed by the registry under contingent arrangements.
