- LCP conducts secondary DVSAT assessment
- · Liaise with DVLO if threat level needs reviewing
- All victims assessed 'At Serious Threat' to be referred to a local Safety Action Meeting (SAM). Victim consent is not required

Step 7- DVLO/DV TEAM

 Liaise with Local Coordination Point re: Victim Safety and review Threat level.



Step 8 - Safety Action Meeting (SAM)

- · Crime Manager or police at an Inspector rank will chair meetings
- DVLO will receive SAM action items and follow up to support/reduce risk to victims.
