VIRTUAL HEARINGS ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ANTI-DISCRIMINATION LEGISLATION

Portfolio Committee No. 5 – Legal Affairs will be holding two virtual public hearings next week for the inquiry into the <u>Anti-Discrimination Amendment (Complaint Handling) Bill 2020</u>.

The Bill, introduced by the Hon Mark Latham MLC, was referred to the committee for inquiry and report in March 2020. The Bill contains amendments to Anti-Discrimination legislation, including the ability of the President of the Anti-Discrimination Board to decline certain complaints and not have to refer them to the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT).

The first virtual public hearing will be held on **Tuesday 9 June 2020** and the second on **Thursday 11 June 2020**. Both hearings will commence at **10.15 am** and will be live streamed on the NSW Parliament's website here: https://www.parliament.nsw.gov.au/Pages/webcasts.aspx.

Chair of the Committee, the Hon Robert Borsak MLC, said 'The committee will be hearing from the President of Anti-Discrimination NSW on the implications of the proposed amendments to the bill. It will also hear from a number of experts and key organisations across both hearing days, including a panel of legal experts, and other representatives of public interest, religious and certain lobby groups'.
