Thank you for your further correspondence concerning the inquiry into the operation of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016.* 

I note your request for a breakdown on the collection of the levy from the individual rideshare services such as Uber, Ola and Didi. I note your further request that, if this information is not available, a breakdown on the collection of the levy from the individual services within the category of booking services providers be supplied.

The *Taxation Administration Act 1996* prohibits the disclosure of information obtained under the administration of a taxation law (section 81), except in certain circumstances. As the information you seek pertains to specific taxpayers and none of the exceptions to the general prohibition on disclosure appear to apply, I am not able to provide you with the breakdowns requested.

I trust that this information is of assistance to you.
