# **SUBMISSIONS STILL OPEN FOR THE REVIEW OF THE COMPULSORY THIRD PARTY INSURANCE SCHEME**

### **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

**17 November 2020**

The Standing Committee on Law and Justice has commenced its regular oversight review into the state's Compulsory Third Party (CTP) insurance scheme, as required by the State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015.

The original closing date for submissions was 24 October 2020, however this has now been extended to **10 December 2020**.

The committee examines the operation of this scheme every two years, in order to determine whether it is performing effectively. For this review, the Hon Wes Fang MLC, Committee Chair, said, 'The committee is particularly interested in receiving submissions on the operation of the 6 month liability period under the scheme, specifically the period claimants are entitled to claim benefits irrespective of fault'.

Stakeholders are invited to provide a submission on this issue and/or the performance of the compulsory third party insurance scheme in general.

Stakeholders should note that the committee does not have the power to investigate individual compensation claims.
