Dear All,

Please forward onto Elizabeth Kincaid as I am off-site and do not have her email handy.

Firstly thank you for your recent correspondence regarding the 'preferred scenario' potential location and siting of the school for the Rhodes East Precinct.

On 14 September 2018 the Governance for Rhodes East Public School (including site selection) was formally established and involves representation from DP&E, NSW Treasury and SINSW. Given this governance is now established, it is essential that any proposals in relation to the location of the school be addressed through this governance structure in order for the impacts be fully evaluated.

SINSW request that DP&E provide a formal submission to this Steering Committee at its earliest opportunity for consideration. Any submission and subsequent meeting will need to detail the investigations to date by DPE and address the current identified concerns by DoE. Note that there are serious concerns raised by DoE as to the robustness of the investigations and the lack of any meaningful consultation with DoE. We would also like details as to the investigations completed for the previously identified site and the rationale for discounting this site. Based on the very limited information we currently have major concerns regarding the value for money and risk for this proposed site. At present SINSW cannot be support this proposal.

In anticipation of this submission can DP&E also advise of their availability for a Steering Committee meeting to be held w/c 15th October 2018.
