

Questions on Notice Select Committee on the Proposal to Raise the Warragamba Dam Wall Uncorrected Transcript, 7 June 2021

Question on Notice

Just to be clear, there were flood warnings and evacuation warnings – I am not sure if there were evacuations orders; maybe you can let us know – in place for parts of the Hawkesbury-Nepean before Warragamba overtopped. Is that right?

<u>Answer</u>

Warragamba Dam spilled on the afternoon of Saturday, 20 March 2021. There were no evacuation orders in place on Saturday, 20 March 2021. There was one evacuation warning in place before Warragamba Dam spilled (Pitt Town Bottoms).

The NSW SES had been engaging with the community and distributing information prior to Warragamba Dam spilling. A number of flood bulletins had also been issued for the area prior to the dam spilling.
