Hearing into Transport Asset Holding Entity to be held this Thursday

The NSW Legislative Council Public Accountability Committee will hold its fifth hearing into the Transport Asset Holding Entity (TAHE) this Thursday 10 February 2022.

Following concerning evidence last year about the establishment and operation of TAHE, the committee will hear from key witnesses including senior officials at NSW Treasury, Transport for NSW and TAHE.

Also appearing will be the NSW Auditor-General who last year delayed signing off the state's accounts due to concerns with TAHE.

Committee Chair, Mr David Shoebridge MLC, said: "Today's scathing report from the Auditor-General on the state finances has raised ever more questions about the conflicts that emerged in the lead up to TAHE's establishment and the concerns surrounding TAHE's current operating model and viability. This hearing will be an opportunity for the committee to put those questions to the key players involved with TAHE and finally get some answers and accountability."
