I cannot find a record confirming an exact date.

Therefore I estimate that the arena material was stockpiled during the period two weeks prior to the above date.

Question 1:

What was the actual cost of producing an original mix.

Answer

The cost (excluding GST) of an original mix was:

Silica Sand: \$13,395

Otto Arena Tex fabric (mixed with the silica sand): \$12,127

• Estimated cost of mixing: \$8,225

Total Cost: \$33,747

Note:

The above cost of \$33,747 represents only approximately 5% of the total cost of the project. This is the same cost as the sand / fabric mix moved from Wallaby Hill to SIEC.
