Ms Abigail Boyd MLC, Chair of the Committee said, 'Due to the Legislative Council resolving to sit today, Friday 1 April to continue debate on the Roads and Crimes Legislation Amendment Bill 2022, the committee unfortunately has had to cancel its planned public hearing with residents, business owners and local councils impacted by the M5 tolling regime.'
